

2023 National Tour Schedule

You determine your day's driving schedule. This is a listing of what is available for you to see along the way. They are listed in suggested order to visit. Your lanyard and name tag will give you discounted group rates at museums not included in your registration fee. The admission charges for the National Automobile & Truck Museum (on Sunday only, beginning at 5pm), the Studebaker National Museum (on Wednesday 10--5 and Thursday from 9am until noon), and the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Museum (on Friday only, beginning at 3pm) are included in your registration fee. You will need your name tag and lanyard for those admissions, as well.

Be sure to wear your name tag to all venues you visit during the week.

**Note: On Wednesday or Thursday (July 19/20), if you want to tour the Indiana Whiskey Company, you will need to visit their website to register. (<http://www.inwhiskey.com/book-a-tour>) They only take small tour groups, registration is in advance and on your own.*
