The club has contracted to hold 35 rooms for this trip at all the hotels along the route. We are not going to limit this tour to any number of participants. However, only the first 35 registrations will be given access to the hotel rooms being held. These hotels have more than 35 rooms, but we have only contracted for 35 at a reduced rate. Registration will open for this tour in early July, and I will send out an email to those folks who have paid their membership dues for the 2017 calendar year a couple of days ahead of time.

a tour, please contact me. Putting together a tour can be as simple or elaborate as you wish to make it. You will find that on the Outer Banks tour, everything to see and do is left to the participant to decide. On the Kentucky tour, several activities have been arranged for you.




