
The Fall 2020 Tour is in the works. Liz Horne will be our host. The details will be published on the website as soon as they are available.

Creamy Chipped Beef

TOTAL TIME: Prep/Total Time: 15 min. **YIELD:** about 4 cups.

Ingredients

- 1-1/3 to 1-1/2 cups milk
- 2 packages (8 ounces each) cream cheese, softened
- 1 package (2-1/2 ounces) thinly sliced dried beef, chopped
- 1/4 cup chopped green onions
- 2 teaspoons ground mustard
- Toasted bread slices

Directions

1. In a large saucepan, heat milk and cream cheese over medium heat; stir until smooth. Stir in beef, onions and mustard; heat through. Serve over toasted bread slices.
